About the role:

You will be providing technical guidance to the Sales team, whilst supporting the company internal design team including Graduate Engineers, Design Engineers and Technicians. This position will support the Engineering Manager and Chief Engineer, and your position will entail supporting with training and recruitment, as well as assisting with bespoke engineering projects.

The main core of the role will focus on delivery of project workload, whilst managing more junior staff and both producing and checking drawings and designs. You will also have responsibility for identifying the training requirements for Graduate and Design Engineers within their job role, and implementing an adequate training plan.

This position will see you actively contribute to internal senior engineering meetings, quarterly team meetings and attending regional and national construction events.

It is ideally suited to someone with IEng professional status with the ICE or IStructE, although the company does have an excellent approved training scheme and an incredible track record in supporting staff to achieve their professional qualifications, so someone who has not already attained Chartered status could be suitable provided they are keen to complete this and actively work towards doing so with the company's support.
